- A differently abled child can be exempted from studying the 3rd language. In this concern, an application (along with the test reports) has to be submitted in the school in class VI, latest by the last week of July.
- **Subject Enrichment Activities:** These are subject – specific activities aimed at enhancing the understanding and skills of the students. These activities will be carried out throughout the term; however, they will be evaluated at the term end.
- **Notebook Submission:** Notebook Submission, as a part of internal assessment, is aimed at enhancing seriousness of students towards preparing notes for the topics being taught in the class room as well as assignments. This also addresses the critical aspect of regularity, punctuality, neatness and notebook upkeep.

1. (a) Work Education: Work Education refers to skill-based activities resulting in goods or services useful to the community.

(b) Art Education: Visual and performing art

(c) Health and Physical Education: Sports/Yoga

2. Discipline: The students will be assessed for the discipline which will be based on the factors like attendance, sincerity, behavior, values and tidiness, respectfulness for rules and regulations, attitude towards society, nation and others.
